

Matthew	Revelation
24:1 - And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to <i>him</i> for to shew him the buildings of the temple.	
24:2 - And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.	
24:3 - And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what <i>shall be</i> the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?	
24:4 - And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.	
24:5 - For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.	13:8 - And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
24:6 - And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all <i>these things</i> must come to pass, but the end is not yet.	16:14 - For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty. 20:8 - And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.
24:7a - For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences,	9:20 - And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: 11:6 - These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will. 15:1 - And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God. 15:6 - And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. 15:8 - And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled. 16:9 - And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory. 16:21 - And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great. 18:4 - And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, That ye be not partakers of her sins, And that ye receive not of her plagues. 18:8 - Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, Death, and mourning, and famine; And she shall be utterly burned with fire: For strong is the Lord God who judgeth her. 21:9 - And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife. 22:18 - For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:
24:7b - and earthquakes, in divers places.	6:12 - And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood; 8:5 - And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake. 11:13 - And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven. 11:19 - And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. 16:18 - And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such
24:8 - All these <i>are</i> the beginning of sorrows.	
24:9 - Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.	2:10 - Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life. 2:13 - I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth. 6:9 - And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: 6:10 - And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? 6:11 - And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled. 7:14 - And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
24:10 - And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.	17:16 - And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.
24:11 - And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.	19:20 - And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.
24:12 - And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.	2:4 - Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. 2:5 - Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent. 2:10 - Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life. 3:15 - I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.
24:13 - But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.	2:10 - Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
24:14 - And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.	11:15 - And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. 14:6 - And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach
24:15 - When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)	13:1 - And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. 13:5 - And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.
24:16 - Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:	13:15 - And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.
24:17 - Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:	13:16 - And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in
24:18 - Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.	

24:19 - And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!	their right hand, or in their foreheads:
24:20 - But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:	
24:21 - For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.	13:5 - And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.
24:22 - And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.	14:12 - Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. 14:14 - And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle. 14:15 - And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe. 14:16 - And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped. 14:17 - And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. 14:18 - And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the
24:23 - Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here <i>is</i> Christ, or there; believe <i>it</i> not.	13:13 - And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men, 13:14 - And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.
24:24 - For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if <i>it were</i> possible, they shall deceive the very elect.	19:20 - And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.
24:25 - Behold, I have told you before.	
24:26 - Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, <i>he is</i> in the secret chambers; believe <i>it</i> not.	19:11 - And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. 19:12 - His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. 19:13 - And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. 19:14 - And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.
24:27 - For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.	19:17 - And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God; 19:21 - And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse. which sword
24:28 - For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.	
24:29 - Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be	
24:30 - And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.	
24:31 - And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.	19:7 - Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. 19:8 - And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. 19:9 - And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.
24:32 - Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer <i>is</i> nigh:	
24:33 - So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, <i>even</i> at the doors.	
24:34 - Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.	
24:35 - Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.	3:14 - And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;
24:36 - But of that day and hour knoweth no <i>man</i> , no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.	3:3 - Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee. 16:15 - Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk
24:37 - But as the days of Noe <i>were</i> , so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.	
24:38 - For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,	
24:39 - And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.	
24:40 - Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.	
24:41 - Two <i>women shall be</i> grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.	
24:42 - Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.	
24:43 - But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up.	
24:44 - Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.	19:7 - Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.
24:45 - Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?	2:13 - I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.
24:46 - Blessed <i>is</i> that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.	2:19 - I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first. 16:15 - Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.
24:47 - Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods.	3:21 - To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne. 21:7 - He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.
24:48 - But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming;	
24:49 - And shall begin to smite <i>his</i> fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken;	
24:50 - The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for <i>him</i> , and in an hour that he is not aware of	3:3 - Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come
24:51 - And shall cut him asunder, and appoint <i>him</i> his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
